From the east: 101 (Ventura Fwy) west (or north). Exit Las Virgenes Rd., turn left on Las Virgenes Rd., turn left onto Mulholland Hwy, turn right into entrance. Stop at the guard gate and tell guard you are attending the Gardening Study School.

From the south: 405 (San Diego Fwy) north to 101 (Ventura Fwy) west (or north). See above.

From the north: I-5 to 405 (San Diego Fwy) south to 101 (Ventura Fwy) west (or north). See above.

From the west: 101 (Ventura Fwy) east (or south). Exit Las Virgenes Rd. See above.
