- 11.Under PERSONNEL COMMITTEE DUTIES (page 16-17) amend as follows:

 1. Strike in its entirety, currently reads: "One (1) blank copy of the Personnel Recommendation Form, the Location Sheet, and completed copy of the Recertification List (the State Garden Club's existing list of recommended members) shall be placed in a kit for each State Garden Cub President and distributed at Fall Board Meeting in the odd-numbered years. These forms may also be obtained from NGC Headquarters or be downloaded from the NGC website."

 Substitute the following: "One blank copy of the Board of Directors Application Form shall be placed in a kit for each State Garden Club President and distributed at Fall Board Meeting in the odd-numbered years. This form may also be obtained from NGC Headquarters or be downloaded from the NGC website."
- 2. Strike in its entirety, currently reads: "The State Garden Club President shall return two (2) completed copies of the Location Sheet and four (4) completed Personnel Recommendation Forms for each of the nominees to the Regional Personnel Representative before February 1 in the even-numbered years. The Regional Personnel Representative shall sign the Personnel Recommendation Forms, send one (1) copy of each to the incoming Regional Director by the Regional Meeting in the even-numbered years and send three (3) to the NGC Personnel Chairman, together with one (1) copy of the Location Sheet, before March 1 in the even-numbered years. The second copy of the Location Sheet may be kept for the Regional files."

<u>Substitute</u> the following: "The State Garden Club shall return three (3) completed copies of The Board of Directors Application Form for each applicant to the NGC Personnel Chairman by February 1 of the even-numbered year."

5. Strike in its entirety, currently reads: "The State Garden Club President shall return the updated Re-certification List to the NGC Personnel Files Chairman by February 1 in the even-numbered years."

4. <u>Strike</u> "a directory update" following "Executive Director" and insert "an updated NGC Roster".

Entire paragraph to read: "The Restricted Section shall contain the following material: minutes of the NGC Conventions and Board of Directors Meetings submitted by the NGC Recording Secretary, monthly and quarterly financial statements submitted by the NGC Accountant; amended sets of Bylaws and Standing Rules submitted by the NGC Parliamentarian; membership figures, special forms, Fall Board Meeting information submitted by the NGC Executive Director; an updated NGC Roster submitted by the Administrative Assistant and any other information the President shall deem necessary. Any financial information that is more than one year old shall be deleted from the Section by this Chairman."

ADOPTED by 2/3 VOTE

5. Add second paragraph to read:

"Any information submitted for publication on the public NGC website will be accepted with the understanding that all text (names, addresses, email, telephone numbers) will be available to the general public. Acknowledgement of this policy will be requested by the webmaster from the person submitting the information." Linda Nelson, Organization Study Committee Chairman, moved to amend by striking "all text (names, addresses, email, telephone numbers) and substituting "contact information and striking last sentence "Acknowledgement of this policy will be requested by the webmaster from the person submitting the information and substituting "Consent to use this contact information must be included on school forms."
