PROCEDURE FOR REINSTATEMENT OF ACCREDITED JUDGE WHO HAS LAPSED FROM GOOD STANDING BEFORE 4 YEARS FROM GOOD STANDING DATE\*

NGC ACCREDITED JUDGE, LIFE JUDGE or MASTER JUDGE

## **REQUIREMENTS**

	Checklist of requirements achieved
Attends all lectures and point scoring sessions for:  a. NGC Flower Show School Courses III and IV; or b. Two NGC Flower Show Symposiums; or c. Either NGC Flower Show School Course III or IV, and one (1) symposium  NOTE: A minimum of four (4) months must pass between the two (2) courses/symposium but no more than three (3) years between schools and/or symposiums. ALL EXHIBITING AND JUDGING CREDITS MUST BE OBTAINED BEFORE TAKING THE SECOND COURSE/SYMPOSIUM.	
Pass ALL written point scoring examinations at the schools or the two symposiums listed above.	
Earn the following:	
<ul> <li>a. Two horticulture ribbons (any color) from an NGC Flower Show; and</li> <li>b. Two design ribbons (any color) from an NGC Flower Show; and</li> <li>c. One ribbon in either horticulture or design (any color, for a total of 5) from an NGC Flower Show; or provide a point-scored horticulture or design exhibit at an NGC Flower Show School, or an NGC Flower Show Symposium.</li> <li>NOTE: Only two ribbons (one horticulture and one design) may</li> </ul>	
count from any NGC Flower Show.	
Judge five (5) NGC Flower Shows with two NGC Flower Show Judges in good standing (Accredited, Life, Master)	
NOTE: A lapsed judge may not serve on an NGC Flower Show Evaluation Panel.	

<sup>\*</sup> If Judge has lapsed more than 4 years from Good Standing date, all judging status is lost, and must complete the entire NGC Flower Show School series again.
