National Garden Clubs, Inc. Schools:

Environmental, Gardening, and Landscape Design Schools provide continuing education to NGC members and the public.

Gardening School is a series of 4 Courses with 10 hours each of instruction over 2 days. Courses cover all aspects of growing, soil, propagation pruning, native plants for wildlife, plant diseases, and specialized gardens.

Each of the courses has an optional, open book/open note, multiple choice test. NGC members wishing to become a gardening consultant must take all 4 courses and pass the tests with a 70 or above test scores. Lecture outlines are provided.

After completing the 4 courses and passing the tests, garden club members are consultants. Consultants must refresh their credentials by the end of the 5th calendar year following the date of the last course or refresher event by attending all lectures of a course in the school for which credit is sought or a single subject refresher approved by NGC Chairman of that school or a Multiple refresher approved by the NGC Multiple Refresher Chairman.

Members who successfully complete all four NGC Schools, Environmental, Gardening, Landscape Design and Flower Show School are honored as NGC 4-Star Members and when they refresh their certification to the Master Status in all disciplines are honored as NGC 5-Star Members.

Master Gardening Advanced Training:

Many Master Gardeners are interested in obtaining more in-depth knowledge about specific topics and in obtaining an advanced level of certification. To provide such opportunities, the Advanced Master Gardener Training Program was developed. The changes to the new Advanced Training guidelines will allow all Master Gardeners, including first year Master Gardeners WHO HAVE COMPLETED THEIR 40 HOURS OF VOLUNTEER WORK, to participate in the seminars for Advanced Training hours.

Attendees must enter their accrued hours in their county time entry under AT hours.
