Horticulture and Flower Show Procedures:

Flower Show Schools were formed to train Judges but they are also a great place to learn horticulture and design for Flower Shows exhibition and Flower Show Procedures. All Club members are welcome to attend all or part of the program with registration fees paid.

- Students are required to bring Handbook for *Flower Shows 2017 Revised Edition* to class. 2017 edition (corrected July 2023) is available on line at the NGC website for free download or \$25 purchase. Homepage/National Garden Clubs, Inc.>Schools>Flower Show School>FSS School Resources
- Students are encouraged to read:
 - *Horticulture Exhibiting and Judging* (\$30)
 - *Outlines of Period Flower Arrangements* by Hannay (\$5)

Both books are available at the NGC, Inc., online store, or from club library for checkout.

CERTIFICATION

Upon successful completion of three courses a student is referred to as a Student Judge and is eligible to join a Judges Council. After completion of all four courses with a passing grade of 70% or more and fulfilling the Judging Requirements, a student is eligible to apply to become a National Garden Clubs, Inc. Accredited Flower Show Judge.
