Claudia Bates is a seventh generation Floridian who has been a member of the Gainesville (Florida) Garden Club for 36 years. Claudia graduated from the University of Florida, is an avid GATOR, and taught Math, English and Gifted Education at the Middle School level.

Claudia is a nationally accredited Master Flower Show Judge, a NGC, Inc. Flower Show Schools Instructor in Design and Symposia and a certified Floral Design Instructor for the Florida Federation of Garden Clubs Design Series developed by the late Bob Thomas. She is a former President of her Circle and Club (622 members), and a former President of FFGC, Inc. She is currently serving on the NGC Board of Directors as a member of the Flower Show Schools Committee. She has been awarded Life Memberships in Gainesville Garden Club, the Florida Federation of Garden Clubs, Deep South and the National Garden Clubs, Inc. She is a Pillar of Pride recipient and a member of the Hall of Fame and a Guardian of Gardening for FFGC. She is

also a member of DAR and UDC Chapters in Gainesville, FL.

Claudia has presented Design Programs for CFAA, OFAD and several State Judges Councils and has taught Symposiums in 27 states and has devised and taught several Contrived Flower (now known as 'fantasy forms') and texturizing plant material workshops for CFAA and several judges' councils. Her designs have been published in the Vision of Beauty, NCG, Inc. calendar, the Florida Federation of Garden Club's calendar 16 times (2019 cover), the FFSJ Design Manual Just My Type and she has two designs featured in the Wafa book, Designing the American Way.
