General information:

The student becomes an NGC consultant after completing all 4 courses and with a passing grade of 70 or more on every exam. These four courses must be completed within seven years. Courses can be taken in any order. Exams are optional. However, if you wish to be an accredited NGC Consultant, you must take the exams. After passing two courses, a student may become a Provisional Consultant and can join a School Consultants Council. To remain in Good Standing, every five years, Consultants must continue their education by attending a School Refresher or a School Course, no exam required. After a Consultant's fourth refresher, the Consultant becomes a Master Consultant. Consultants or Master Consultants may earn refresher credit only once within a calendar year.
